<p>Write each spelling word five times in your notebook.</p>	<p>Create a flashcard for 15 of your spelling words. On the front, write the word correctly. On the back, write the definition or a picture clue.</p>	<p>Write your spelling words in reverse ABC order in cursive once and printing once in your notebook.</p>
<p>Use Scrabble tiles or tiles from Upwards to spell your words. Have a parent check your words. Then, have the parent sign a page in your notebook and write a quick note indicating you completed the activity.</p>	<p>Use 15 spelling words in a sentence in your notebook. Correct spelling and grammar count! Each sentence must be at least 10 words. Underline your spelling word.</p>	<p>Write a spelling pyramid for each of your spelling words in your spelling notebook.</p>
<p>Create a wordsearch or crossword puzzle and include each of your spelling words. Solve it and bring in an extra copy. Remember to solve your own puzzle and bring in a copy of the puzzle to share.</p>	<p>Spend at least 20 minutes on the website quizlet or www.spellingcity.com . Bring in a note signed by a parent stating that you completed this assignment.</p>	<p>At home, cut cards or paper into 3 inch squares. Make enough for each spelling word. You and a parent should each make a set. Lay the cards face down and then play Memory/Concentration. Bring in the cards.</p>
