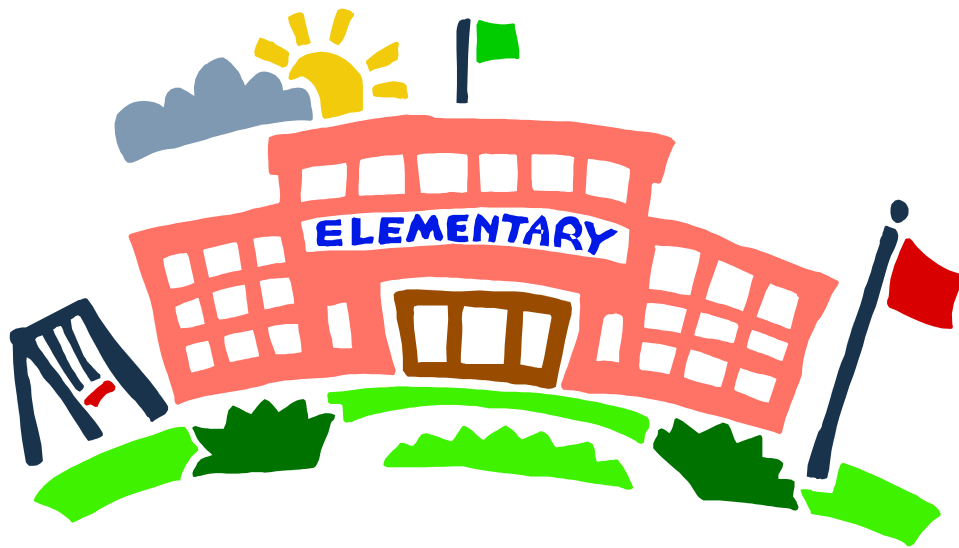

The after school open lab allows students to use all grade level software programs that are loaded on the computers, print classroom projects, and visit selected sites on the Internet. Structured lessons are not given but story writing and illustration is encouraged. Students in grade three who register will use Typing Pal and Reflex Math the first ten minutes of Open Lab. Students in grade 2 will be required to use Reflex Math the first ten minutes of class. This class will run from 2:55-3:55. Students should bring a peanut free snack and a drink. Students should be picked up in the Delaney Computer Lab.
