ART ADVENTURES CAMP **JULY 31-AUGUST 4, FROM 8:00–12:00** **\$210**

Your adventures begin in Adobe Photoshop with basic image manipulation, drawing in Adobe Illustrator and design and layout in Adobe InDesign. Using the Adobe Creative Suite, campers can create an interactive media project to wrap all their new found skills.

COSMETOLOGY CAMP **JULY 24-28, FROM 8:00–12:00** **\$210**

Campers will work in a real beauty salon and learn how to style hair, create nail art and practice professional skin care techniques. Bring your individuality and artistic flair to this fun-filled week!

CYBER CAMP **JULY 24-28, FROM 8:00–12:00** **\$210**

Cyber Camp provides campers with an opportunity to learn, use and experience new technology in a fun and engaging way! We will be creating web pages, Android apps, build a computer, create a game using RUBY on the raspberry Pi.
