### Mission




- We recognize that children grow at varying rates.




### Bus Information



- We try our very best to have all Kindergarten stops at their driveways.
  The exception is some roads are too narrow, still under development, or are too dangerous for a large school bus to traverse. In those cases, the closest and safest bus stop will be assigned.
- In some cases, close neighborhoods with many school-aged children will have group bus stops with priority given to kindergarten students.
- Bus routes and bus stops are determined through a partnership with Holmes Bus Company and the school.
- Families will receive an email mid-July with transportation information.
- Bus routes are posted on the school website mid-late August.

### Bus Information



- Bus behavior: We have a program to teach specific bus riding expectations in late August. You will be invited to a Kindergarten Bus Orientation and students will also receive classroom instruction on school bus safety.
- K students sit in the front of the bus.
- Teachers and paraprofessionals greet students daily as they exit the bus and walk students directly to their buses at the end of the day.
- All bus drivers are CORI checked and highly trained.
- Bus-related questions can be directed to the Assistant Principal.

# Building Safety



- All doors are locked once school begins at 8:20 AM.
- Any person entering the school after 8:20 AM must ring the buzzer and report to the office.
- All visitors must sign in using our Raptor Security System and wear a badge.
- Late Arrivals & Early Dismissals: Parents/caregivers are asked to remain in their cars in front of the school and call the number posted. The office staff will assist you in getting your child into the building or sent out for dismissal.
- Identification is required for all dismissals.
- CORI checks are required through WPS for all field trip chaperones.





# Requirements



- All children must be 5 years old on or before August 31, KINDER
  2024 to enroll.
- All children must be fully toilet-trained before the start of school.
- All registration and medical paperwork must be completed through Aspen Family Portal.
- As your child's first and primary teacher, you know your child best. You must rely on your instincts and trust the judgment of those in your environment who know your child well. Though a child may be academically prepared for the rigors of Kindergarten, he or she must also be ready to face the social and emotional changes as well.

# Screening



- Screening is mandated by Massachusetts DESE
- Screening is designed to assess basic readiness skills and identify students who may be in need of support services: concepts, motor and language
- Screening times will be set up by appointment via SignUp Genius
- The screening appointment takes about an hour
- Current Project Blossom students <u>do not</u> need a screening appointment



# Kindergarten Kickoff



- Thanks to the generosity of our PTO and WEST, we are offering a FREE four day summer program to help prepare all incoming kindergarteners for school and extend the screening process in the areas of social, emotional and play skills
- Sessions will be held during the weeks of July 15, July 22, and July 29.
- Sessions will be held Monday through Thursday from 8:15-11:15 AM at the Delaney School
- Sign ups for Kindergarten Kickoff will be set up via SignUp Genius once student registration is completed
