

Wrentham Public Schools Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (FY21) Full-Day Kindergarten Tuition Sliding Fee Scale

Wrentham uses family income data at enrollment to determine financial aid for the following school year. Families applying for meal assistance in 2020-2021 will need to reapply when the new rates are published and new forms are available at the start of the school year, but Financial Aid for tuition will not change once an award is confirmed by letter. Should family circumstances change during the year, a new application and request for aid may be submitted at any time.

To apply for assistance, a complete and accurate Household Application for Free and Reduced Price School Meals must be submitted and a signed form for the student enrolling in Kindergarten authorizing the information from that Application to be shared with the Business Office.

All students with a Notice of Direct Certification of Eligibility for Free School Meals will have tuition waived if a signed authorization to share information is received.
